Walk in the Fruit of the Spirit.

Know the direction God wants you to walk in.

Gain revelation from the Word of God to accomplish victory in your everyday life.

After a lot of discussion and looking in to many scriptures each week we always came back to the same answer – the main key to living in victory is to walk in love. There is no other area of scripture that defines how we are to walk in love than ! Corinthians 13. So for the next few weeks we are going to look deeper in to what I Corinthians 13 teaches us. Let's get started.

### I Corinthians 13

1) Vs. 4a Love is patient (makrothumeo);

Pronunciation: **mak-roth oo-meh'-o**

- 1) to be of a long spirit, not to lose heart
  - 1a) to persevere patiently and bravely in enduring misfortunes and troubles
  - 1b) to be patient in bearing the offenses and injuries of others
  - 1b1) to be mild and slow in avenging
  - 1b2) to be longsuffering, slow to anger, slow to punish

2) Vs. 4b ...love is kind (crhsteuoami)

Pronunciation: **khaste-yoo'-om-ahee**

- 1) to show one's self mild, to be kind, use kindness
-

3) It does not envy (zeloo), ...

Pronunciation: **dzay-lo'-o**

- 1) to burn with zeal
  - 1a) to be heated or to boil with envy, hatred, anger
  - 1a1) in a good sense, to be zealous in the pursuit of good
  - 1b) to desire earnestly, pursue
  - 1b1) to desire one earnestly, to strive after, busy one's self about him
  - 1b2) to exert one's self for one (that he may not be torn from me)
  - 1b3) to be the object of the zeal of others, to be zealously sought after
  - 1c) to envy

4) ...it does not boast (perpereuomai),...

Pronunciation: **per-per-yoo'-om-ahee**

- 1) to boast one's self
  - 2) a self display, employing rhetorical embellishments in extolling one's self excessively
-

5) ...it is not proud (phusioo).

Pronunciation: **foo-see-o'-o**

- 1) to make natural, to cause a thing to pass into nature
  - 2) to inflate, blow up, to cause to swell up
  - 2a) to puff up, make proud
  - 2b) to be puffed up, to bear one's self loftily, be proud
