NET © It is not glad about injustice, but rejoices in the truth.

NIV © Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth.

NASB © does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth;

NLT © It is never glad about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out.

MSG © Doesn't revel when others grovel, Takes pleasure in the flowering of truth,

BBE © It takes no pleasure in wrongdoing, but has joy in what is true;

NRSV© it does not rejoice in wrongdoing, but rejoices in the truth.

NKJV © does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth;

1. Vs. 6a ...does not rejoice (chairo)...

Pronunciation: khah'-ee-ro

- 1) to rejoice, be glad
 - 2) to rejoice exceedingly
 - 3) to be well, thrive
 - 4) in salutations, hail!
 - 5) at the beginning of letters: to give one greeting, salute

2) Vs. 6b ...in unrighteousness (adikia),

Pronunciation: ad-ee-kee'-ah

- 1) injustice, of a judge
 - 2) unrighteousness of heart and life
 - 3) a deed violating law and justice, act of unrighteousness

3) Vs. 6c ...but rejoices (sugchairo)...

Pronunciation: soong-khah'-ee-ro

- 1) to rejoice with, take part in another's joy
 - 2) to rejoice together, to congratulate

4) Vs. 6d ...with the truth (aletheia);

Pronunciation: al-ay'-thi-a

- 1) objectively
 - 1a) what is true in any matter under consideration
 - 1a1) truly, in truth, according to truth
 - 1a2) of a truth, in reality, in fact, certainly
 - 1b) what is true in things appertaining to God and the duties of man, moral and religious truth
 - 1b1) in the greatest latitude
 - 1b2) the true notions of God which are open to human reason without his supernatural intervention
 - 1c) the truth as taught in the Christian religion, respecting God and the execution of his purposes through Christ, and respecting the duties of man, opposing alike to the superstitions of the Gentiles and the inventions of the Jews, and the corrupt opinions and precepts of false teachers even among Christians
 - 2) subjectively
 - 2a) truth as a personal excellence
 - 2a1) that candor of mind which is free from affection, pretence, simulation, falsehood, deceit
